On Monday, we got the eggs out of the cups and were surprised to see the effects of the drinks on the eggs. Sugary drinks, orange juice and Coke were the worst for the eggs, wearing away the shell and leaving a rough sugar layer on them. Fizzy drinks, Coke and Diet Coke stained the eggs brown/black.
