Prior to the Parents Evening, planned for later this half term we will have a printed copy of your child's records which will be handed to you personally at the Parents Evening for you to check and sign and return immediately back to the school.

Attendance

Please remember that if your child is unable to attend school for any reason it is important for parents to notify the school, by phone, ***on each morning of an absence*** to confirm why they will not be in. This important procedure is in place for safeguarding reasons. I am sure you would agree that it is important for everybody to know where the children should be, as soon as possible, on a daily basis. Please be aware that if your child has **3 or more days** unauthorised absence within 4 weeks the school may be required to refer for a penalty notice.

Our attendance figures for the week ending Friday 14th September 2018 are as follows – Gold is awarded to Blue with 99.3%, silver to Orange Class with 97% and bronze to Green Class with 96.7%.
