# **Secondary Transfer 2019 - Year 6 Pupils**

As the parent or guardian of a child currently attending Year 6 you will, no doubt, be thinking about the next stage of your child's education and their transfer to secondary school at the start of the next academic year. The Admissions Team are currently accepting applications for places in September 2017 Year 7 intake. As there is no automatic transfer from Primary School to Secondary School, you will need to make an application for your child's secondary school place; this must be received by the Admissions Team on or before the national closing date of 31 October 2018. If you do not submit an application you will not be offered a school place. Please be aware of which school you wish to apply for and which County Council you need to apply through.
