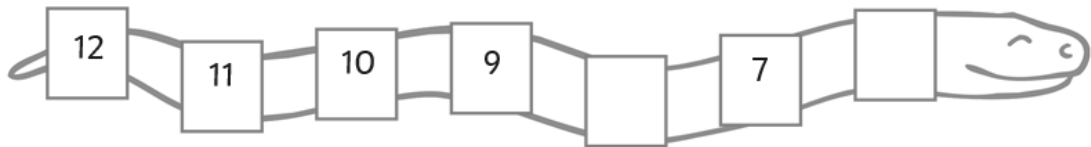
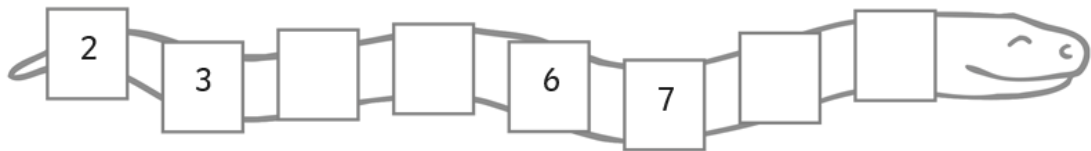
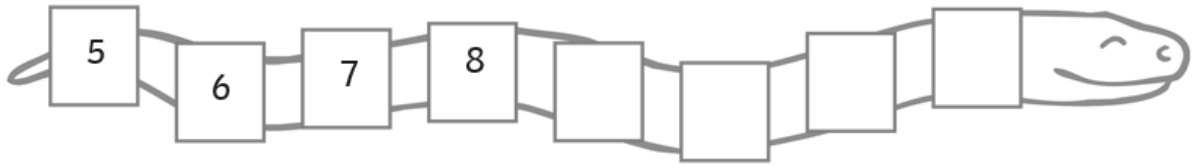
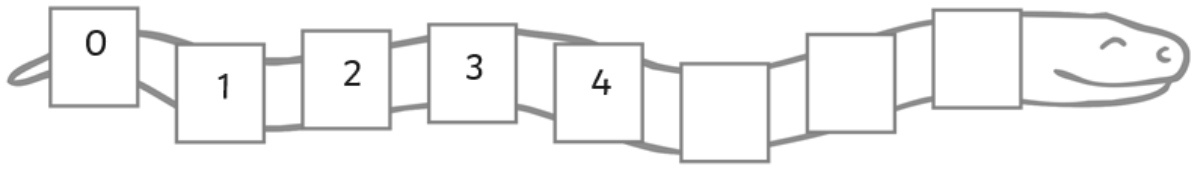


Due Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> September

The project is a free choice in this topic area. You could choose to build a boat at home, make a model of Nelson, paint or write about Nelson's famous ship called 'HMS Victory' or anything else you would like to create on this topic!

1. In Maths this week we have been comparing and ordering numbers. Complete the sequence snakes. **Challenge: Can you compare two numbers on the number line? E.g.:**  
5 is greater than 3  
 $5 > 3$   
4 is fewer than 7  
 $4 < 7$
2. In English we have been learning about the story of Sailor Bear. Draw, paint or make a picture of the bear from the story on the sail boat paper. Don't forget the sailor suit! Write 3 words to describe him. **Challenge: Write a sentence to describe your character, remembering a capital letter, finger spaces and full stop!**
3. This week we would like you to have a go at reading the tricky words on the PowerPoint. If you can read the words, can you spell them too?
