Can you read the number? What is one more? One less? Can you count on or back from that number?

You could write them on paper, with chalks outside, use paint or use your finger to make the letters in sand, shaving foam or anything else you can think of! **Challenge:** Have a go at writing the word 'cod' with joined letters.
