1. In Maths this week we have been using part part whole models to represent addition. The 'whole' number is in the circle which is attached to the others. The other numbers are the 'parts' that make the whole number. Have a go at making your own part part whole models at home. You could draw them on paper or make them with toy hoops or paper plates. **Challenge:** Can you make a part part whole model with 3 or more parts?



2. In English this week we have been learning about nursery rhymes and rhyming words. Make a list of your own rhyming pairs. E.g. cat, sat; chair, bear; dark, mark; ear, hear.

Here are some online rhyming games to have a go at. The first game is matching rhyming words from a choice of 3 and the second helps you to create a rhyme about a shark!
