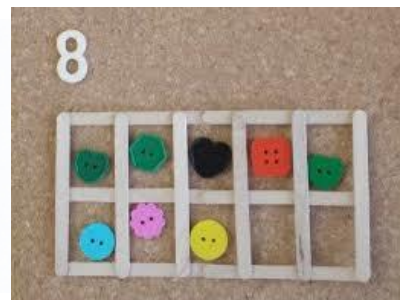
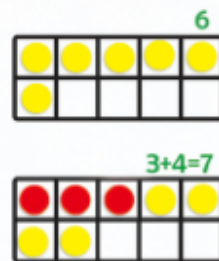
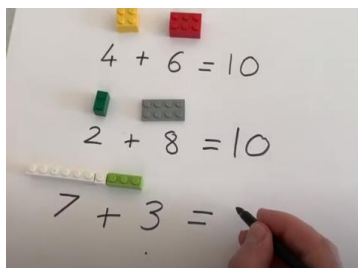

1. In Maths this week we have been using number bonds for different numbers to 10. Choose a number and represent the different ways to make that number at home. E.g. you could use lego bricks and count how many bumps are on the bricks, or count how many bricks you have. **How many different combinations can you find?** We have also been using tens frames to make numbers to 10. You could draw your own to use at home or make one using straws or lolly pop sticks. Use any small objects at home to make numbers to ten. E.g. toys, pasta shells or even sweets!



2. In English this week we have been learning about nautical nursery rhymes and thought of our own versions. Choose a simple nursery rhyme and play around with making your own version. You could change one word or one line at a time and see if you can make a crazy rhyme! For example twinkle twinkle racing car, I wonder how fast you are! You could perform your rhyme or write it down.
3. Please find a high frequency word list in the front of your child's reading record booklet. Choose a few words a week to practice reading and writing. These can be ticked off on the chart.
