### Harvest Collection

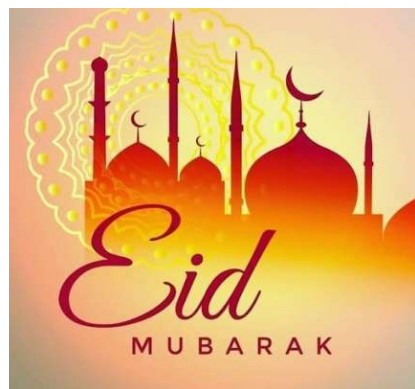

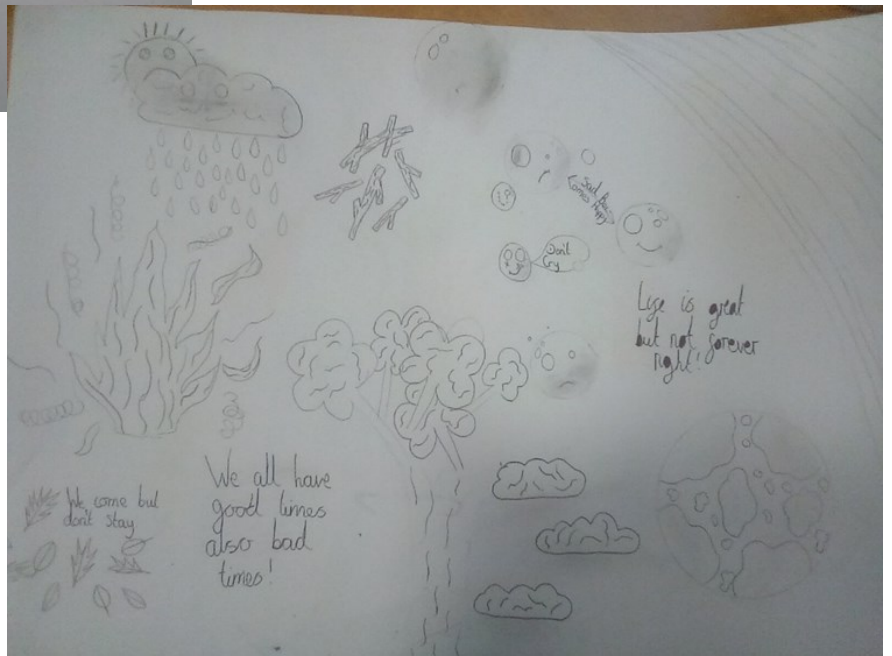
