

# Red class homework!



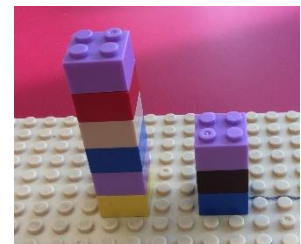
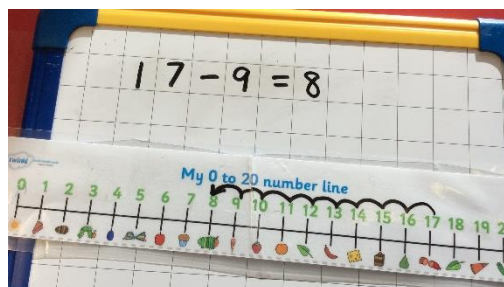
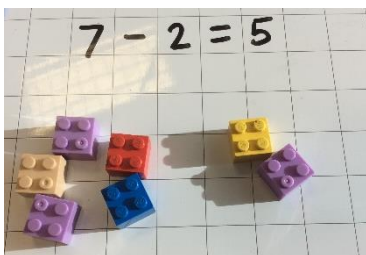
Due Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> November

Ongoing topic project due in the last week of this half term (Week beginning 14<sup>th</sup> December). Our current DT topic is about moving toys so I would like you to enjoy a free choice project in this topic area. You could look at old and new toys to see how they have changed, build a ramp and see which of your toys travels the furthest or ask your parents or grandparents about their favourite toys.

1. In Maths this week we have been subtracting and finding the difference. Ask an adult to write you some subtraction questions using familiar numbers. Use some lego bricks or other small objects at home to help you subtract. You also have a number line in your homework book that you could use instead. **Challenge: Build towers using different sized lego bricks and count the bricks to find the difference between them.**



2. In English we have been learning about story settings. Write a list of 5 describing words for the setting in the picture. **Challenge:** Write sentences with some of your describing words.



3. Please continue to work through the high frequency word list in the front of your reading record booklet. Can you read all of the words? Time yourself to see how quickly you can read them all. **Challenge:** Can you spell them all by Christmas?
