

## Yellow Class Spellings

Spelling rule/guidance – This week – Hyphens can be used to join a prefix to a root word, especially if the prefix ends in a vowel letter and the root word also begins with one. Using hyphens can also avoid confusion with existing other words, for example repress and re-press.
