Ongoing topic project due in the last week of this half term (Week beginning 14th December). Our current DT topic is about moving toys so I would like you to enjoy a free choice project in this topic area. You could look at old and new toys to see how they have changed, build a ramp and see which of your toys travels the furthest or ask your parents or grandparents about their favourite toys.

1. In Maths we have been subtracting this week. Choose numbers from Pudsey's coloured spots to make your own subtraction number sentences. You could use any small objects at home to help you (lego blocks, dried peas etc). Or use your number line in your book. **Challenge: Draw part part whole models to represent your number sentences. Can you include 3 parts to your part part whole model?**
2. In English we have been learning about the 'Funnybones' story by Janet and Allan Ahlberg. Write some words to describe the dark, dark town in the picture. **Challenge: Write a sentence to describe the town. You could even include an AA sentence with 2 adjectives next to each other e.g. There is a big, bright moon.**
3. Please continue to work through the high frequency word list in the front of your reading record booklet. Can you read all of the words? Time yourself to see how quickly you can read them all. **Challenge: Can you spell them all by Christmas?**
