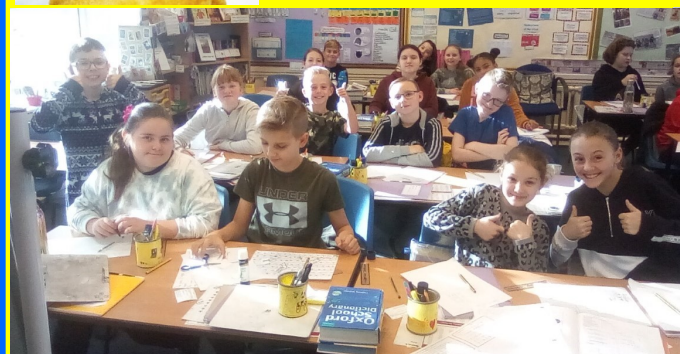

We created a class wreath constructed from handmade poppies to take out to the playground in preparation for the 1 minute silence. We also explored artefacts from Miss Heath's late grandfather, including medals, war tins, Sergeant Major pass and sweetheart pins. The children thoroughly enjoyed this learning opportunity and asked some thoughtful questions regarding conditions during the war.

Following on from that, on Thursday afternoon, Orange Class used traditional, authentic Viking techniques to create Viking soap and Viking bread, using locally foraged and sourced ingredients. Thank you to Miss Bagg for helping with these activities. If ever you run out of soap, I am sure the children will be able to whip up some conker soap for you!

On 11th November, Year 6 walked to the village's War Memorial. They were able to think about the soldiers who died in the First World War (and the Second World War) and also to consider local names, soldiers who were related and dates when the soldiers died.

The children looked at wreaths and personal tributes that had been provided by the local community to honour these soldiers.

Whilst at the memorial, we shared poems and a prayer, as well as having some silent reflection time. On return to the classroom, the children explored the Roll of Honour for Outwell and found out more information, including the soldier's rank and where they served, who their parents were and where they are buried.

Beaupre Fundraising Group is a small, friendly committee made up of parents, carers, grandparents and staff of Beaupré. We have a lot of fun organising events for the children in a relaxed and welcoming way. In the past we have organised Halloween Discos, Christmas and Summer Fayres, Easter celebrations as well as the Year 6 leavers' Prom and much more. All of the profits made from the events go into the school to help buy equipment and resources for the children of Beaupré. Previous fundraising money has bought a story telling chair, playground toys, a climbing wall, picnic benches, character litter bins, an outside class room, and a wooden play area. We also provide the new Reception children with a book bag each and the Year 6 children with their leavers' hoodies.
