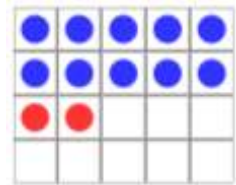
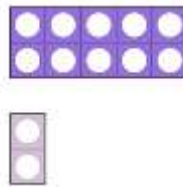
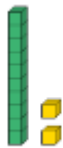

Choose your own well-known character and think of a problem they might have e.g. Baby Bear's problem was Goldilocks eating all his porridge and breaking his chair! Draw a picture of your chosen character and their problem.
