Please make sure you are reading to an adult every night or as often as possible.

1. In Maths this week, we have been finding one more and one less and comparing groups and numbers. Look out for numbers all around you when you are at home or outside. Can you think of the number that is one more? One less? Whenever you have 2 groups of objects or find 2 numbers try to compare them. E.g. "This plate has 3 carrots but that plate has 4 carrots. 4 is one more than 3." **Challenge: Go for a walk and look out for house numbers. Can you count the house numbers on one side of the street going up in twos? Can you count back on your way home? What is the greatest house number you can find? What number would be one more? One less?**

We have found counting on quite easy but counting back can be trickier for some of us. This could be something to practice at home with an adult.

2. In English this week, we had our first go at a phonics check. The children all worked extremely hard and enjoyed showing off their phonics knowledge! As part of the check, the children have to read 'alien' words to check their segmenting and blending skills. Please find some more alien words to practice reading below. **Challenge: Make your own alien words using the sound cards to build a made up word. You could also draw a picture of a new alien for each word!**
