Rainbow Class have been making magical reindeer food to sprinkle on the lawn. Father Christmas very kindly supplied us with biodegradable magic flying dust.



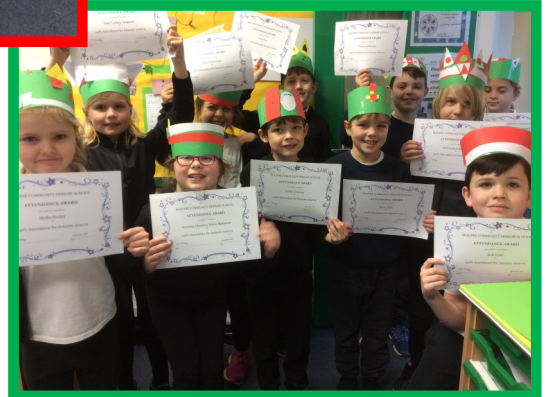
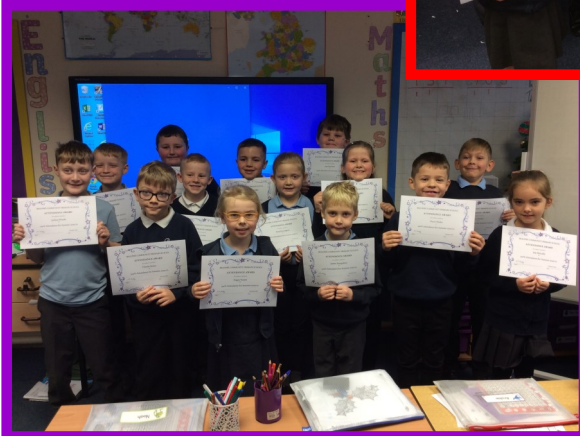

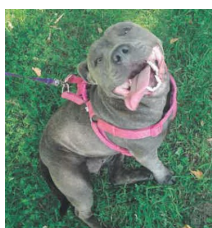
This month's 'Caught Reading' winner is Oliver in Red Class. Well Done
