Lateral Flow Tests

We have had a few parents advising us that they have used the lateral flow testing kits for their children when they feel unwell and are showing symptoms of Covid. These kits are for regular testing to pick up cases where people may not be showing symptoms (asymptomatic). If your child is showing symptoms, an LFT is NOT to be used to test for Covid. Our advice for anyone showing symptoms would be to call 111 and book a PCR test.


