Charity Skydive

On Saturday 17th April, I took part in a charity skydive on behalf of Muscular Dystrophy UK. I was due to jump last March but due to Covid-19 it had to be postponed, so this experience has been a long time coming and even longer for my nerves! It was an incredible day, the atmosphere was amazing and everyone who took part were very encouraging of one another, which is exactly what you need when jumping 10,000 feet from a plane. My fantastic husband (who suffers himself with Muscular Dystrophy and who was the inspiration for my involvement in the skydive) and three daughters were all there cheering me on and waving their posters of support. It was certainly a once in a lifetime experience but I am not sure it is one I would want to repeat!

Muscular Dystrophy is a nonprofit charity, who rely solely on all the generous donations of the public to fund research into muscle wasting conditions in the hope there will one day be a cure, as well as to provide support to those not only with muscle wasting conditions by providing specialist equipment, but also their families. The Duke of Edinburgh was the ambassador for Muscular Dystrophy UK, therefore Saturday felt an even more appropriate opportunity to jump, in light of his funeral. 
