Miss Knight - 100 Miles for Mind



Sunny Weather

As we are now seeing warmer weather, can we please remind you to help protect your child from the sun and the heat that they:

- Bring in a named water bottle daily
- A hat is strongly advised to keep the sun off the children's heads during any outside activities, including breaks and lunchtimes.
- Sun cream should be applied before coming to school in the morning. Staff can oversee pupils applying if necessary, but are not permitted to apply it.



ParentPay Debts

Please help us by making sure that you have sufficient funds on ParentPay for all meals and breakfast club bookings before school on that day. If your account is in arrears above £7, we may write to you to request your child brings in packed lunches until the account is in credit.

ParentPay can be set to automatically send you an email when your balance reaches a pre-set amount (choose communications and then alerts to set this to your chosen amount). For example, if you set the school meals' balance alert to £4.60 you will get an email 2 days before you need to add funds.




Attendance Matters
