## Water Safety Day

Summer has arrived, heat waves are forecast and the summer holidays are just days away now. With all of this in mind, and the fact that we have been unable to go for our usual swimming lessons this year, Beaupre held a whole school 'Water Safety Day' on Wednesday.

We learnt about how to keep ourselves safe near rivers and on the beach and what to do if somebody needed help in the water in an emergency.

We know that we shouldn't go into the water, but should shout to them and throw things to them that might help them to float or to pull them out.

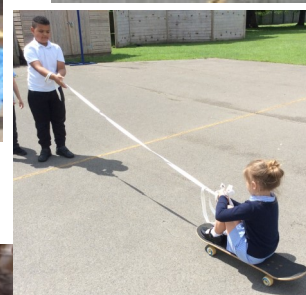
We practiced our skills through a range of activities which included: Catching and throwing exercises to practice our accuracy - saving lives with bean bags and hoops; testing different elongated materials to attempt to retrieve someone in water; a message relay reminding children of the core principles to 'Call 999' and 'Time Saves Lives' and pulling in floating people to the shore or riverbank.

Some classes were also able to look at boats and take a close look at examples of the safety equipment used by the Water Rescue team of the Fire Brigade when they are working.

Children were able to create a set of rules and good advice for staying safe near bodies of water, which different classes presented in different ways.

We are all looking forward to getting back to swimming from September, but in the meantime we hope that the children, as well as enjoying their day, will remember the water safety advice to "stop and think" and to "stay together" when near water.

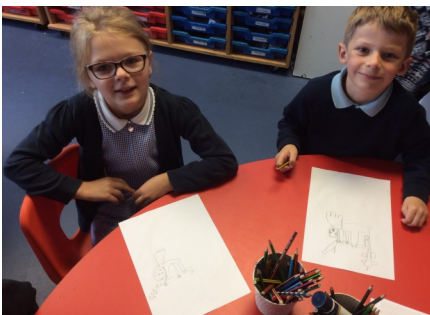
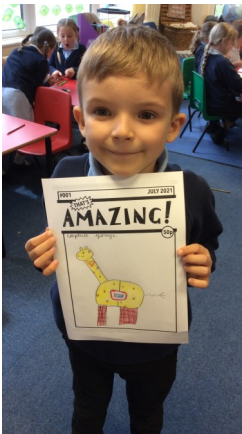
## News....

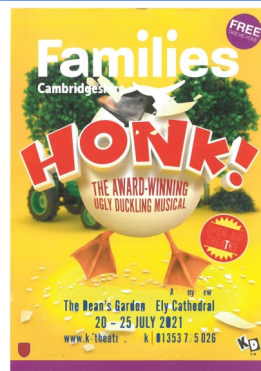
As the end of the school year approaches, we ask that you bring you account up to date so that any debt on your account does not carry forward to the new school year.
