Monday 19th and changes to Government Guidance.

With the end of term fast approaching and the Government's guidance changing on the 19th July, I wish to keep you updated with how this affects our school.

ParentPay

We have a number of parent accounts in debt for which we are having to chase payment on a daily basis at a cost to the school. Please can we ask for your co-operation in ensuring your child's Parent Pay account remains in credit at all times for school lunches. If your account is in arrears of more than £7, then we may request that your child brings in packed lunches until the account is in credit.

As the end of the school year approaches, we ask that you bring your account up to date so that any debt on your account does not carry forward to the new school year.

ParentPay can be set to automatically send you an email when your balance reaches a pre-set amount (choose communications and then alerts to set this to your chosen amount).
