I wish you all a wonderful weekend.

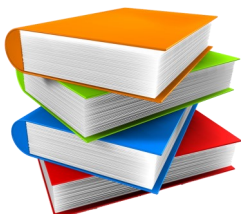

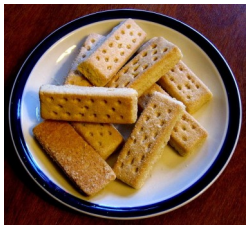
Reading Rivers
