Mrs Eaves made the salad at the same time so that we could see and talk about all the different ingredients.



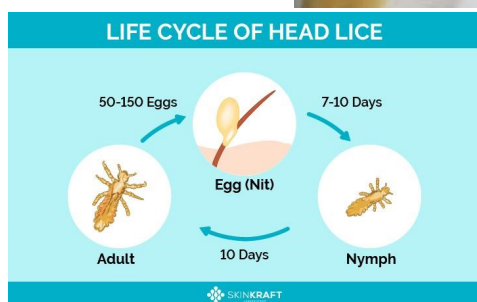
Important Information
