On 11th November, Year 6 walked to the village's war memorial. They were able to think about the soldiers who died in the First World War (and the Second World War). They were able to consider local names, soldiers who were related and dates when the soldiers died. Whilst at the memorial, Holly shared her powerful WW1 poem and the class had some silent reflection time. On return to the classroom, the children explored the Roll of Honour for Outwell and found out more information, including: the rank the soldier had; where they served; who their parents were and where they are buried.

If you are a new parent, you will have received an email from Pupil Asset. This email gives you online access to Pupil Asset to enable you to book a Parents' Evening appointment with your child or children's class teacher/s.

We suggest that you open the email and follow the instructions to set up an account with Pupil Asset, **using the email address that we hold for you**. You will be asked to set your own password.

After you have registered, you can download from Google Play or IOS App Store. It is called the Pupil Asset Parent App—it is a free app. Once you have the app, you can log on using the email address and password you have set. The app also allows you to update your personal details, such as address and telephone updates.

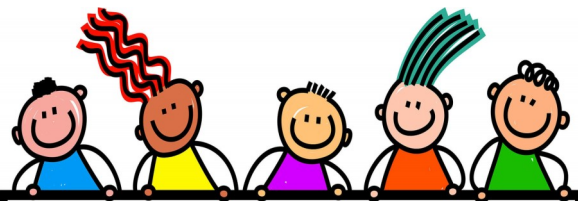
Our attendance figures for the week ending Friday 5th November are as follows:

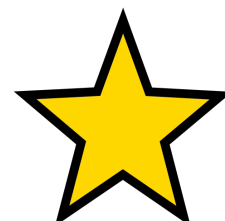
