#### Face coverings and New Guidance

As of the 27th January 2022, there is no requirement to wear face coverings in communal areas or for visitors. As cases are on the rise locally, we will support anyone who wishes to continue to wear face coverings at drop off and collection and when coming to the school office.

#### **Positive cases**

We will send a letter to the class affected and possible close contacts. We continue to ask that a you advise us of positive LFD and PCR results for your child so that we can correctly mark their absence and know when to expect them back in school.

Guidance appears to be changing weekly at present and we would advise that you continue to check on the Government website for the most up to date information on reporting cases and isolation requirements.

## **Important Information**

#### Attendance

Can we please remind you that if your child is not going to be in school for any reason, that you MUST contact the school every morning. The purpose is to record accurately their attendance, but most importantly so that we know where children are. We have had a number of cases where we have not been informed of why a child is off school and have been unable to make contact with parents via text, calls or emails. Our procedure, in line with our policy for those that do not contact us is:

- Text parents/carers
- Email parents/carers
- Make phone calls to parents/carers
- Make phone calls to other contacts provided
- If we can not make contact, we will carry out a home visit. If no one is there we will leave a letter to ask you to make contact. If we do not hear following this, we will contact the police as a matter of a safeguarding concern.

The winner of the 100% attendance prize for week ending Friday 14th January is Florenze in Red Class!




#### Wisbech Schools' Attendance Prize
