On Tuesday we also said a farewell to our Chair of Governors. Jo Pallett was a governor for many years at Beaupré. When I took on the Headship in September 2017, Mrs Pallett was also elected Chair. She saw us through two OFSTED inspections and has been of great support to the school, staff and myself. We will miss her and we wish her the very best with her move to Scotland and her next adventure.

Yellow Class has had an exciting week! On Monday, they visited Stories of Lynn where they were able to enhance their understanding of their current topic: Crime and Punishment. The children partook in a range of activities which included: creating a timeline for the history of The Old Gaol House, learning about criminal torture techniques of the past, meeting Grace Warren (local spinster who was accused of being a witch in the mid-1600s), learning about the motivations of Witchfinder General – Matthew Hopkins and playing key roles in the trial of Grace Warren where both prosecution and defence provided emotive and powerful arguments – our Judge certainly asserted her authority by her calling order in the court and defence barristers even received rounds of applause from the gallery! The children were able to use their knowledge to produce impressive pieces of writing: a newspaper article and diary entry.



## Bikeability

Year 5 have participated in Bikeability this week, having the opportunity to learn the Highway Code and improve their cycling skills when travelling on the road. This included: safety, signalling, turning a corner, stopping and starting, setting off and manoeuvring around vehicles.

We were applauded for the outstanding behaviour of our children. Certificates and badges were handed out in class today and mentioned within the achievement assembly. I am very happy to announce that 100% of the children who took part in Bikeability achieved their level 1 qualification and aspects of/ all of their level 2 qualification.

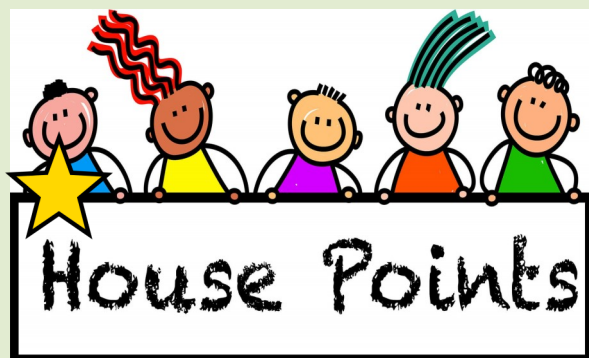
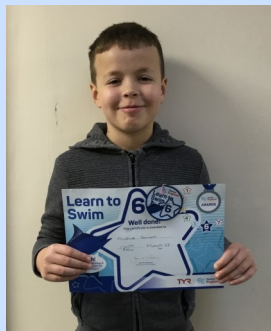
Our attendance figures for the week ending Friday 26th March are as follows:
