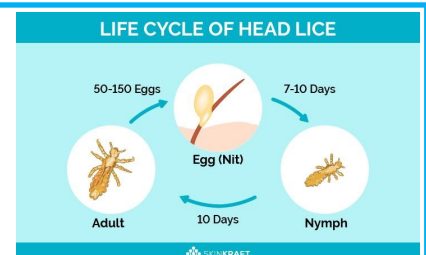

Congratulations to Johnathon from Rainbow Class.

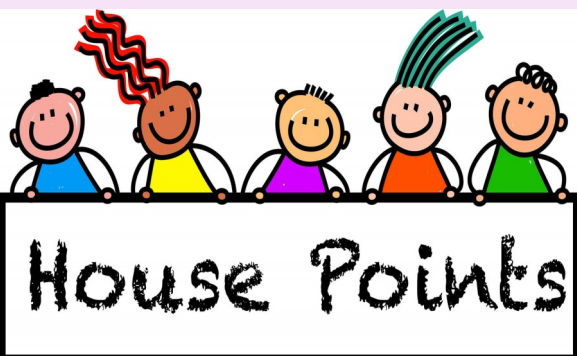
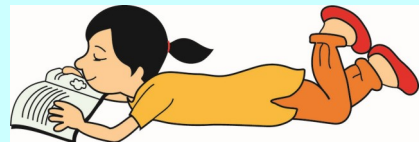
Johnathon spent his bank holiday Monday doing a sponsored walk for the RNLI. He walked a mile and has raised £185.
