Ancient Egyptian Day in Green Class

Green Class travelled back 5000 years on Thursday and took on the challenge of preparing for the burial of Khufu in his Great Pyramid. We started off with a flyover of the pyramid and the building site using a computer simulation before learning about the mummification process. Being amateurs, we have practiced our embalming skills on apples rather than humans and will find out whether we have successfully preserved them for the afterlife next week.

The next step was to try our hand at wrapping the body from head to toe (in that order) in bandages and building a sarcophagus to keep them safe for their journey. We decorated the sarcophagus in a way that we thought would be fitting for a king.

During the wrapping process, amulets would be hidden in the bandages to bring good fortune. We carved a scarab amulet out of soap to represent rebirth and a new dawn for our king. We also decorated the walls of his tomb with images of our favourite Ancient Egyptian gods, paying particular attention to making sure they were facing sideways.

Finally, we made a shubti (model servant) to serve him in the afterlife, sculpting them from one piece of clay and thinking carefully about what they could do to serve the pharaoh in the life beyond.

The day was very busy and the children worked hard from start to finish. They all looked amazing too, thank you for the work you did in helping to create the buzz that kept with them all day.


Our attendance figures for the week ending Friday 13th May are as follows:

Well done to Ezra for taking part in a ballet show at the weekend.



Poppy-Fae for coming 4th overall and 3rd in Bar and Floor at her gymnastics competition
