Bag2School

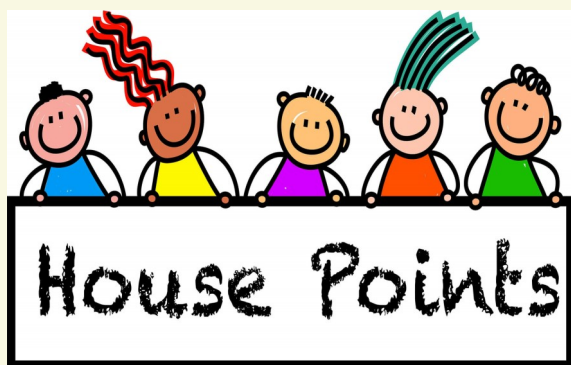
Children will be given a Bag2School bag to bring home during week commencing 27th June.

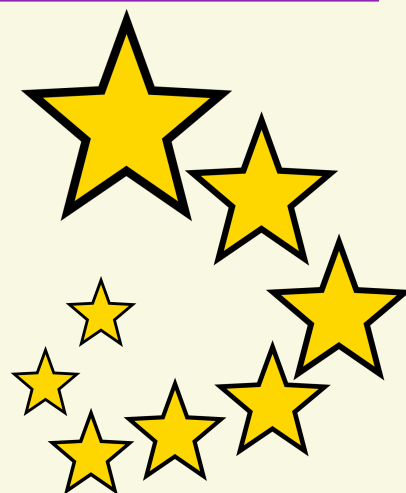
