Yellow Class News

Yellow Class has had an exciting and fun-filled week following their SATs!

At the start of the week, the children explored recipes and followed a recipe to allow them to make chocolate cakes. They then used this information to write instructions. Additionally, the children spent time considering suitable adjectives to describe the look, smell and taste of their chocolate cake. This enabled them to write a narrative about spotting the cake, naughtily eating and then getting caught in the act!





The children have also extending their science knowledge with regard to living things this week. The children conducted an experiment to explore the best conditions in which yeast will activate and were able to formally record their experiments. On Thursday, the children were fortunate to have a visit from a Police Constable. They were able to further their knowledge about the Law and the Criminal Justice System. Subsequently, the children were able to write informative non-chronological reports using this information.













On Thursday 23rd May, Yellow Class were fortunate enough to benefit from a visit by PC Tracey James. The children learnt about what happens when someone is arrested and how this is consequently referred to the courts. This important procedure is in place for safeguarding reasons. I am sure you would agree that it is important for everybody to know where the children should be, as soon as possible, on a daily basis.

Please be aware that if your child has 3 or more days unauthorised absence within 4 weeks the school may be required to refer for a penalty notice. Additionally the school may be required to ask for medical evidence in order to authorise more than 3 days off sick.



We have continued to see a rise in lates, and would remind you of the importance of your child being in school on time every day to ensure they get the best start to the school day and do not miss out on any learning.

How to Book

To book your child into the sessions please come to Weasenham Lane Sports Entrance Reception Area

We will then book your child onto the sessions you wish. In the event of cancelation you will need to give us 48 hrs notice prior to the activities for a full refund. If less notice is given, then 50% of the amount will be kept by the Centre.

We can take bookings via telephone for the courses but full payment will need to be made no more than 48 hrs after booking; failure to do this will mean your child is not guaranteed on the course.

Outside Activities

We will try where possible to use our outside facilities as much as possible. Please can you ensure your child comes to the courses dressed accordingly and with sun cream protection in the event of good weather.

Packed Lunches

We do have a water machine on site that your child will have access to. We do not have food on site so we advise strongly that your child brings a packed lunch, especially if they are staying all day.

Medical Conditions

Please make the staff aware if any medical conditions change from when you fill in the medical questionnaire.

Drop off/Pick up

On the forms prior to the course you will allocate a member of the family or family friend to pick up your child at the end of the sessions or day, they will need to sign their child out for safety purposes. If this person is not available, then alternative arrangements will need to be made for the collection of your child. Prompt pick up is advised.
