Bookings will be available to book from 9:00a.m 2nd October 2023 via the parent portal.


<u>Headlice</u>

Skipping Workshop

What a Wednesday!! We were lucky enough to be visited by Coach Chris, a skipping coach, who spent some time with every class. He began by teaching us the basics of how to skip on the spot, starting off slowly and then speeding up. The next step was to skip backwards which was definitely a little bit trickier. As we mastered those skills, he upped the game and taught us a couple of tricks with "side swings" and "crosses" to really make us concentrate. Along the way we had a series of small competitions to see who could skip the longest and some classes got the chance to try jumping over the long rope while Coach Chris held the end for them.

At lunchtime, the skipping ropes were out on the playground so that we could have a practise and develop the skills and tricks that we had learnt through the morning. We are hoping that this will now be a regular opportunity for our children. Coach Chris also popped out for a little while to see how we were getting on by ourselves and, with Mr Davies' help, gave a couple of lucky people the chance to try jumping the double ropes which took even more concentration and got quite complicated.

To finish a fabulous day, Coach Chris led an assembly where he talked about the importance of perseverance and practice before he showed us some incredible skipping tricks including the quintuple jump which involved spinning the rope around five times in one huge jump! There was then a highly competitive staff skipping competition before a final Q&A session.

Everybody thoroughly enjoyed the day and we hope many of the children will take up the opportunity to continue skipping and will be able to build their own routine of tricks, with a bit of perseverance and practice. Mr Davies
