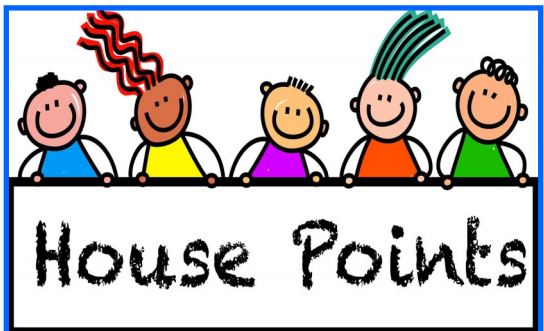


The winner of the 100% attendance prize for week ending Friday 22nd September is Harrison in Green Class.

Max in Yellow Class received a trophy for 'Man of the Match' whilst playing for his football team Outwell Swifts.



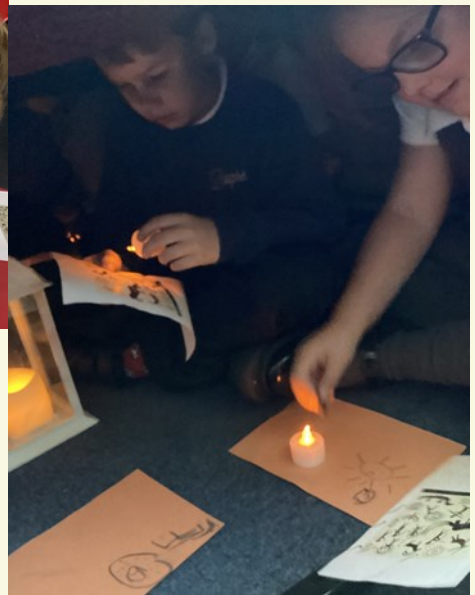
Well Done All!
