This half term, Blue Class have been enjoying their Art lessons, learning about drawing. We explored making marks on different kinds of paper and used a range of art medium. We then responded to music using different types of marks to represent how the music made us feel. Our final work of art used paint to create marks to represent the waves of the ocean. We took inspiration from the artist Beth Krommes and in particular her engraving entitled 'Waves'.



In RE, we have been learning about Judaism. The children enjoyed making Challah bread, which is a plaited, Jewish bread, baked to celebrate Shabbat and other festivals. The children worked in groups to make the dough and then plaited their own loaves. In the afternoon, the children got to sample their bakes and it was a thumbs up from the vast majority!



In PE, we have been enjoying dance which links in with our current topic on the Fire of London. The children have created their own dances to represent the flames of the fire and enjoyed performing their poses and dances to each other on the new outdoor stage in the adventure playground.

In Class, the children have also enjoyed learning more about the Fire of London in our History lessons. We have been asking and answering questions, investigating what happened and learning about how we remember the fire today.
