Our First Woodland Session

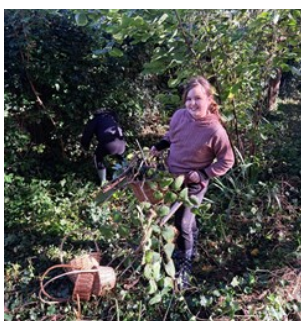

In the afternoon, Rainbow had the chance to work with Woodland Julie, which also incorporated 'The Gruffalo' story.

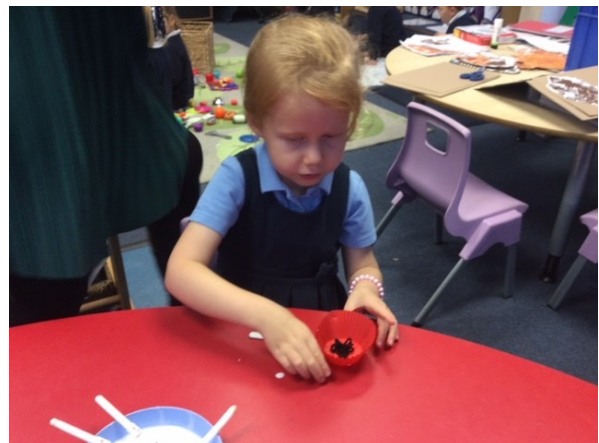
Well done and a huge 'thank you' to everyone involved. We can NOT wait for the next session and we are sure all children who will be involved are looking forward to it too!

Rainbow Class have been learning about Remembrance Day. Mrs Eaves read a true story about Stubby the dog who travelled to France with the US army during the war and helped save lives. He was a real war hero. We learnt that the poppy helps us remember soldiers who died during conflict. Everyone made their own poppy and we planted them in our own little Flanders Field.



Yellow Class—War Memorial Walk

To complement their learning on WW2, on Thursday 9th November, Year 6 walked to the village's war memorial, wearing their hand-crafted poppies. They were able to think about the soldiers who had died in the First and Second World Wars and were able to consider local names, soldiers who were related and dates when the soldiers died. Connie shared her emotive poem and the children listened to 'For the Fallen' by Laurence Binyon after two minutes of reflective silence. The children's maturity and sensitivity at this solemn mark of respect was extremely impressive.

Orange Class followed in the footsteps of Yellow Class, visiting the war memorial on Friday 10th November to pay their respects to all the fallen soldiers. 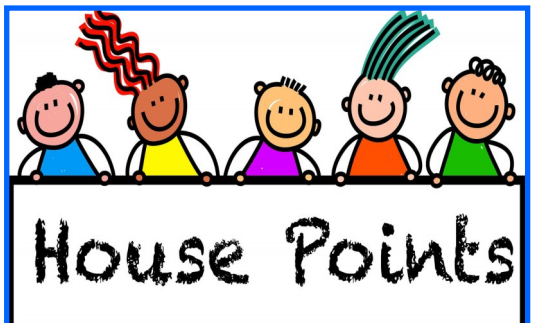
