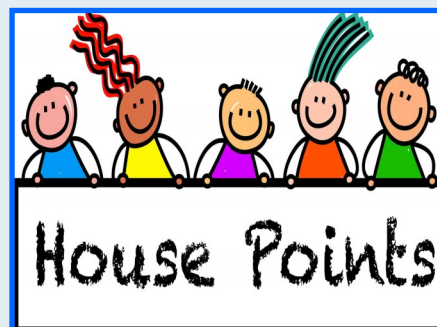

Mya in Red Class received a certificate at her theatre school for being 'Star of the Week'.

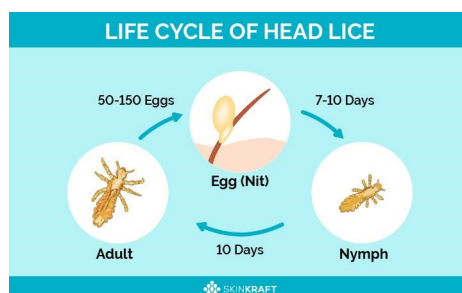
Information

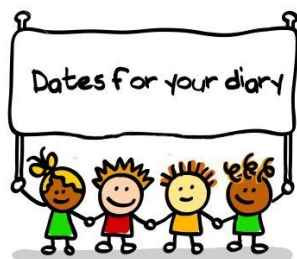
Sweet Cones
