Attendance

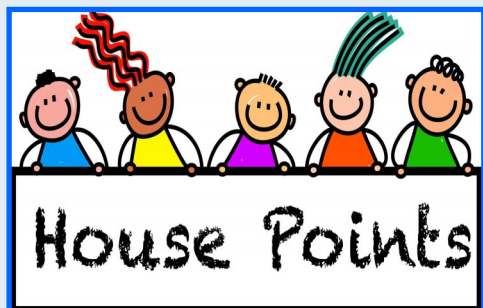

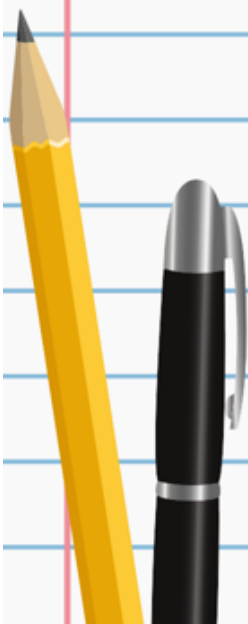
