Have a wonderful weekend with family and friends.

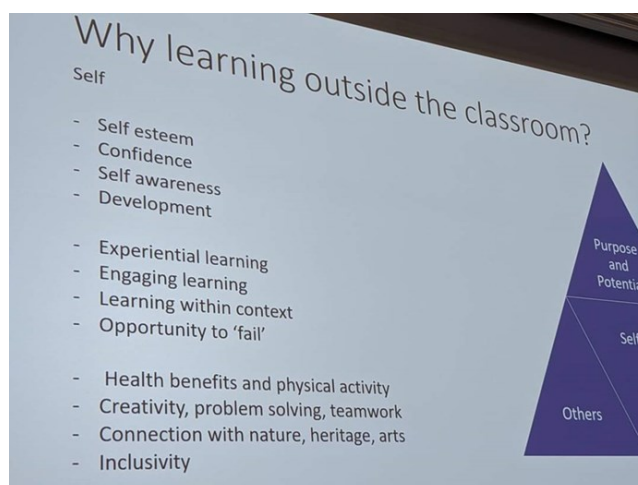

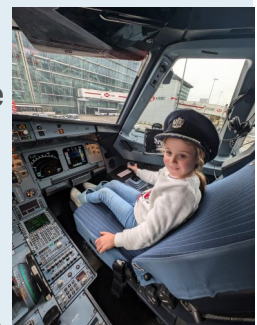
For the week ending Friday 15th November, Maple, Oak & Elder Classes 'attendance was over 96% and they have received a star.

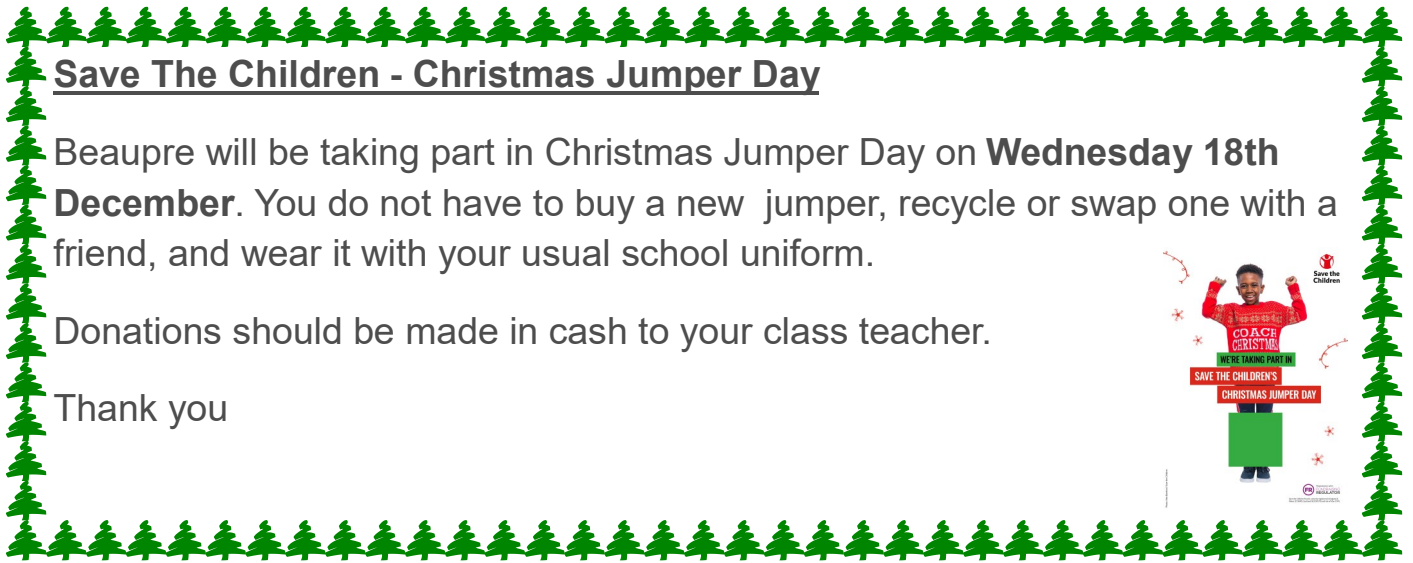

Christmas Nativity - KS1

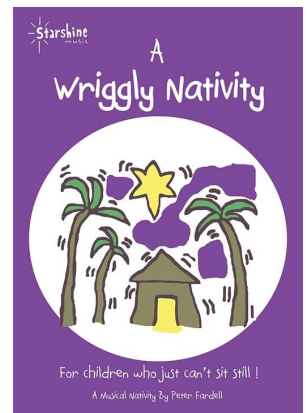
This year we are performing A Wiggly Nativity and are pleased to invite KS1 parents/carers to join us on:-

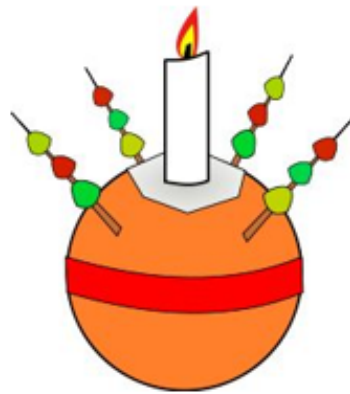


Christmas Post box
