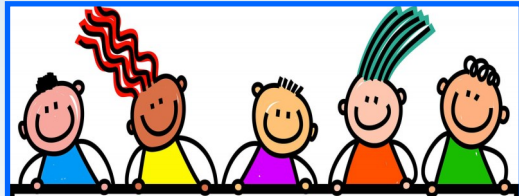

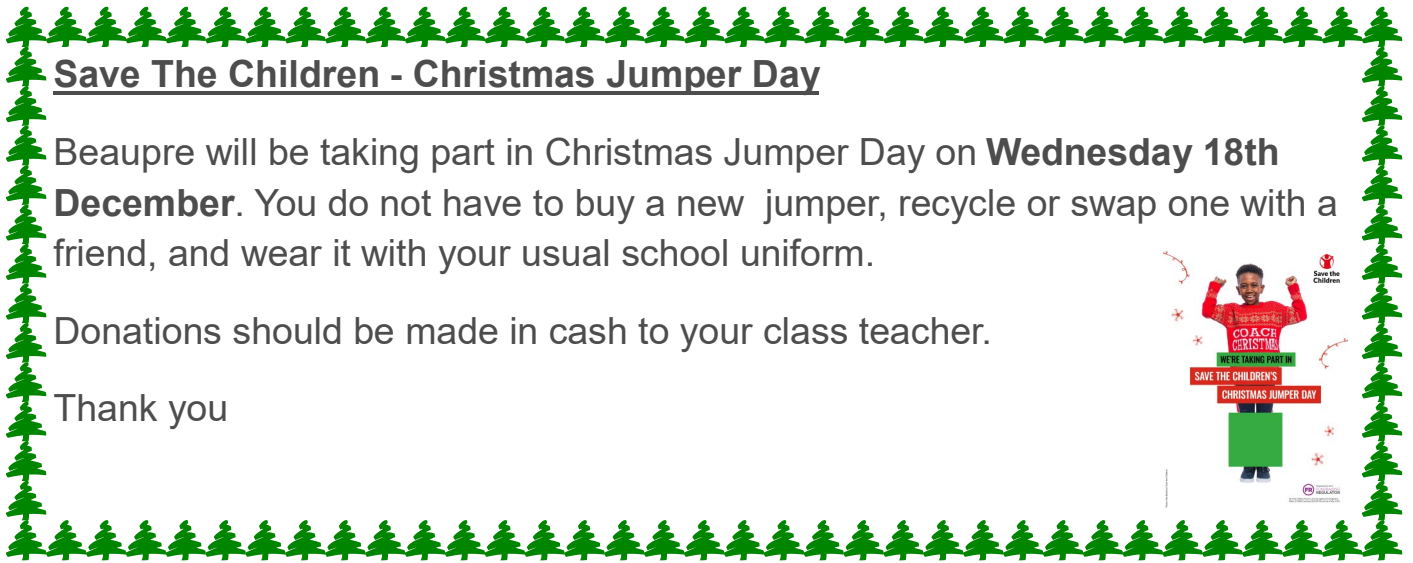

Christmas Nativity - KS1

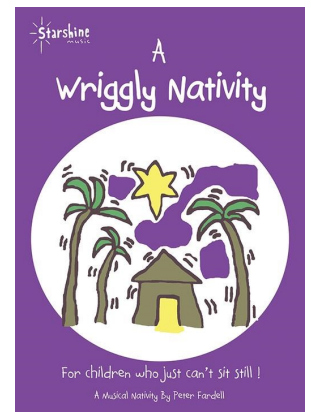
This year we are performing A Wiggly Nativity and are pleased to invite KS1 parents/carers to join us on:-
