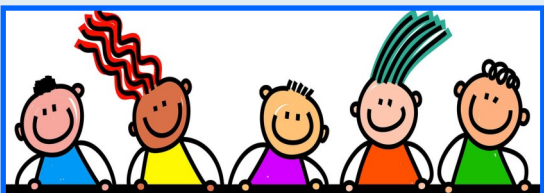

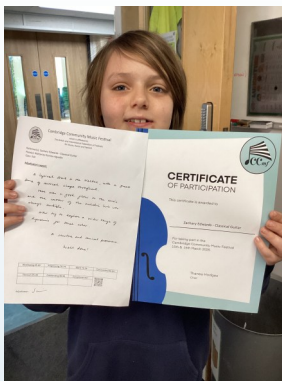


Outside Achievements

Mental Health Support Team

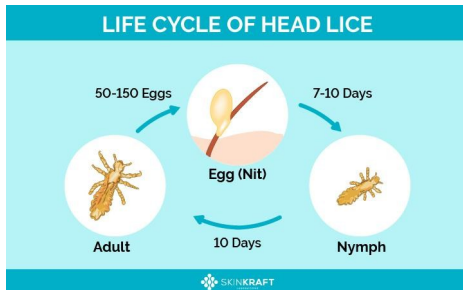
