This week we sampled Chicken Korma and Vegetable Korma, lots of the children took the opportunity to try the dishes, many going back for a second sample and some asking for the recipe.

The children were then asked to vote on the meal and as you can see the curry dishes were a hit!

The new menu will be live on the school website and Facebook page shortly. Aspens have kindly provided the recipe for the Chicken Korma, which is below. The Korma dishes feature in Week 3.

Please find below the recipe for the Chicken Korma. This recipe makes 10 portions, surplus can be frozen to use at a later date.

Chicken Korma

Ingredients

- 550 grams chicken meat, cut into pieces
- 15ml Rapeseed oil
- 200g onions, finely chopped
- 3 cloves garlic, finely chopped
- 10g ginger, grated
- 600g tomatoes, chopped
- 2g Madras Curry Powder (mild)
- 3g Turmeric powder
- 3g Garam Masala
- 150 ml coconut milk (light)
- 30g Tomato Puree
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 200ml Water

How to make

- Make the homemade curry sauce as per the recipe below
- Cook the chicken until golden brown
- Stir in the coconut milk and cooked chicken into the homemade curry sauce

Homemade Curry Sauce

- Heat oil in a large wok. Sauté onion until golden brown.
- Add garlic and ginger and saute. Cook for 2 mins.
- Add curry powder, turmeric, and Garam Masala. Cook for 2 mins.
- Add in the tomato puree. Cook for 2 mins.
- Add in the chopped tomatoes and water. bring to the boil and simmer for 20 mins.
- Add salt and pepper to taste.
- Serve with white rice.

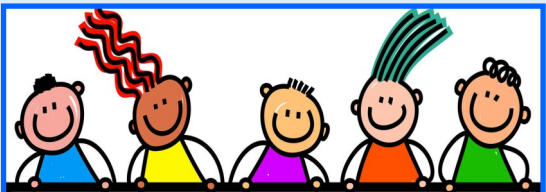
