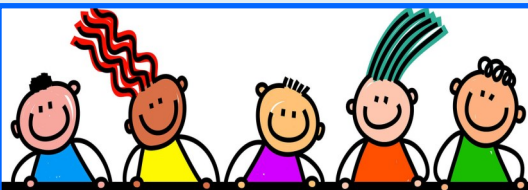

Tilly in Laurel Class completed Level 4 'Learn to Swim' and received a certificate.



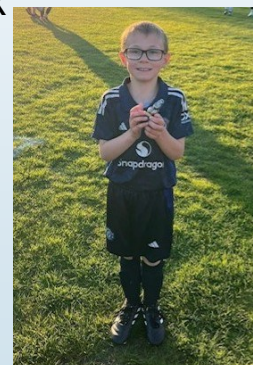

## Our school milk scheme

Beaupre will be providing a milk scheme that will be available to all of our pupils from 12th of May. A letter and registration form was emailed to parents today, if you wish your child to receive milk in school you will need to register before 2nd May, as per the email. If your child is eligible for FSM your child will bring home a paper copy of the form. Please complete and return this by 2nd May 2025.

- Milk is provided by 'Cool Milk'
- Free for children under 5
- Subsidised for over 5s
- When your child turns 5 you can choose to pay for milk - this is done directly with 'Cool Milk'
- We recommend that you register with Cool Milk when you receive the registration form, so that they can contact you before your child turns five



- 189mls of semi-skimmed milk every day. Provided in recyclable Tetra Pak cartons
