If your child took part in the workshop, please encourage them to practice all the moves they have learnt to make sure they all know the dances before the event.

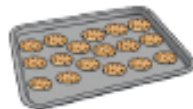




Chestnut Class - Healthy Wraps

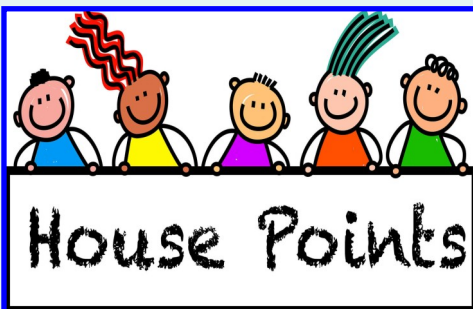
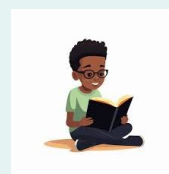

This week's Above and Beyond goes to Lilly-Mae in Elder Class for her hard work and dedication to TT Rockstars at home.

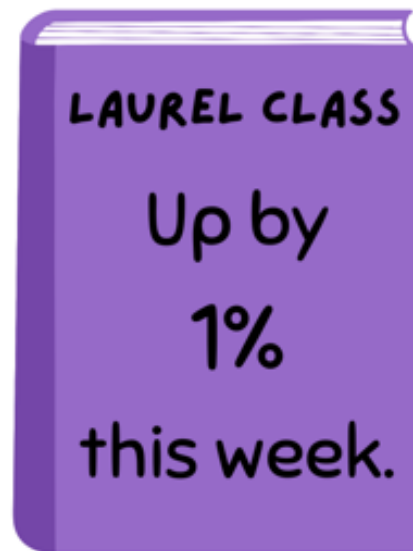
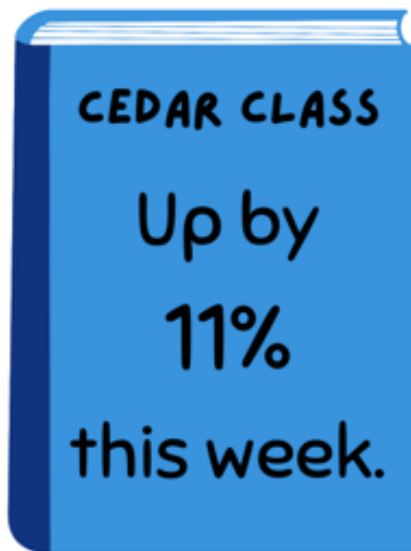


REMARKABLE READING

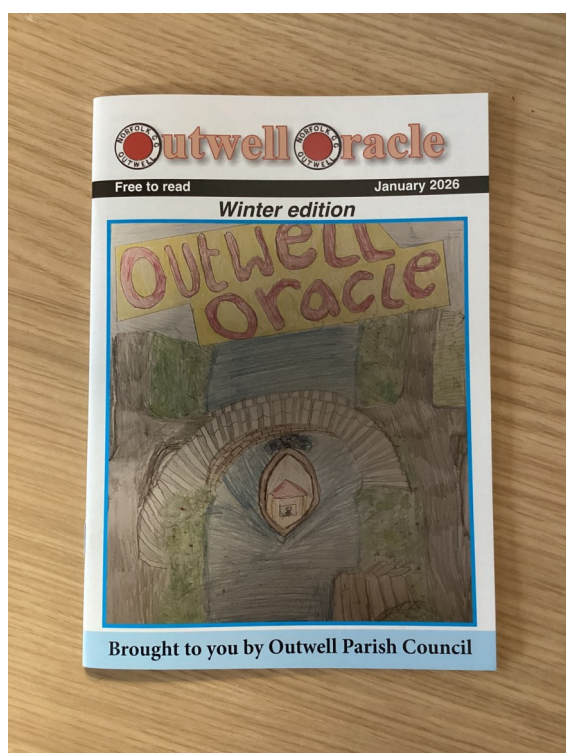
