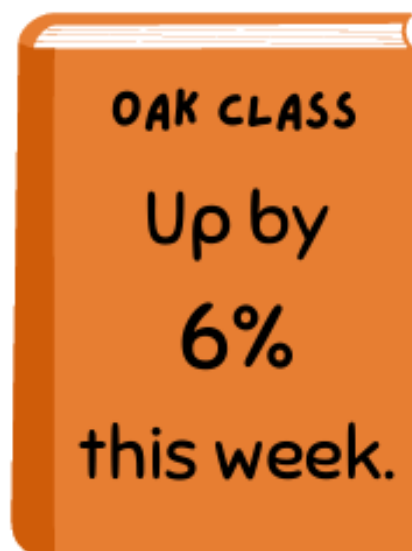
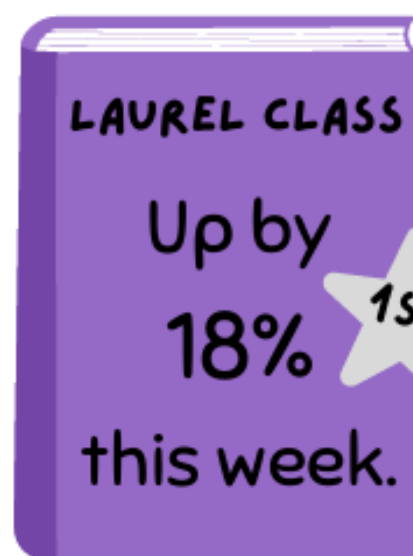
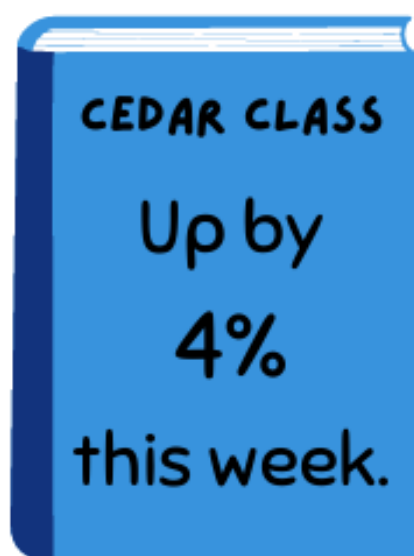


# REMARKABLE READING

**Hope in Cedar Class received a medal for being the best wrestler at her club.**





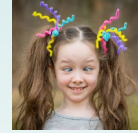

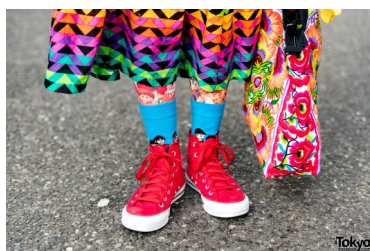
