This year, we have set our accelerated reader users a challenge – which class can improve their reading the most this year?

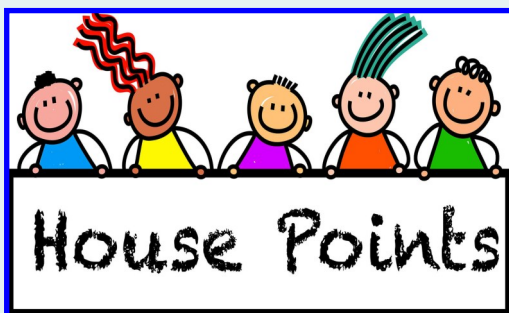

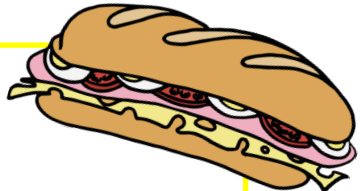
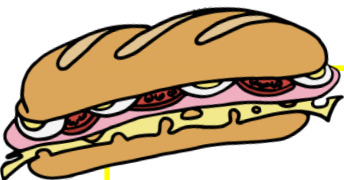
Parent - Woodland Sessions (Updated Version)
