Exciting OPAL News



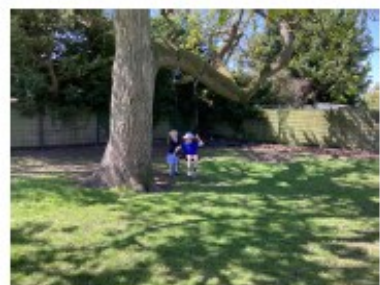

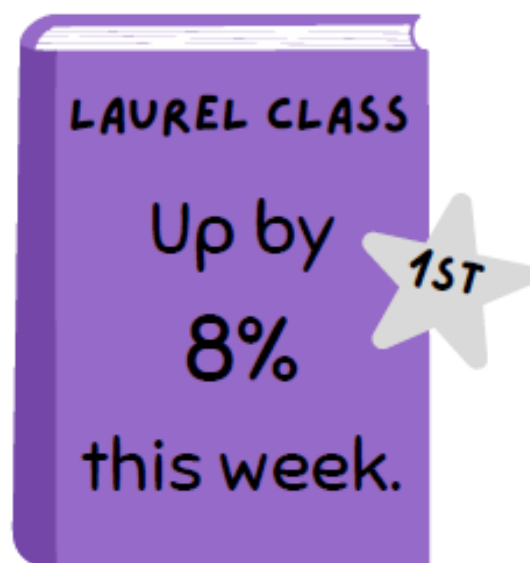
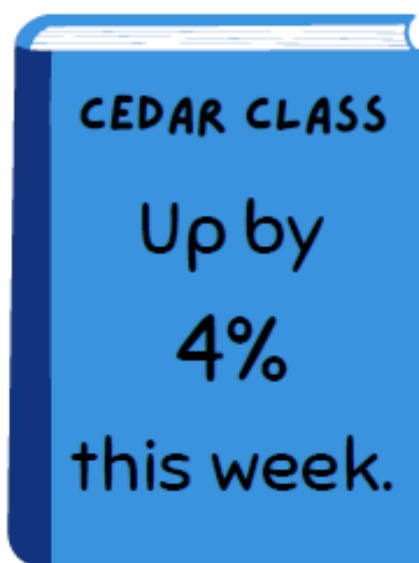


REMARKABLE READING

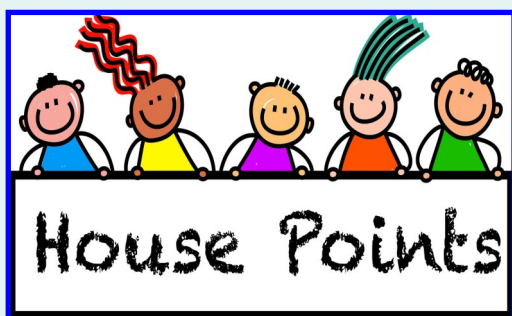
WOODLAND SESSIONS

Ellie in Cedar Class received a certificate for achieving Level 3 Learn to Swim.





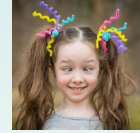

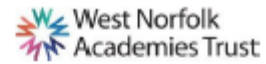
