Sunflowers must be measured on or before 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2026 using a tape measure from floor to the top of the flower head.

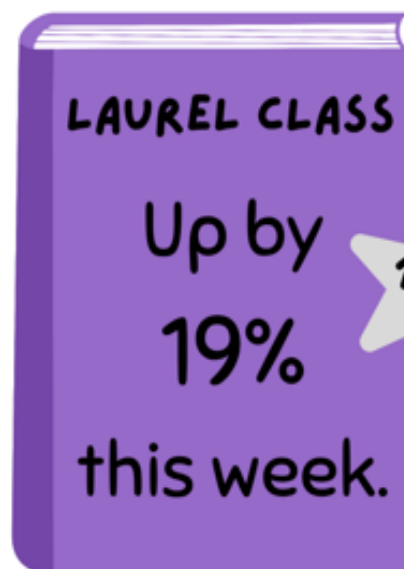
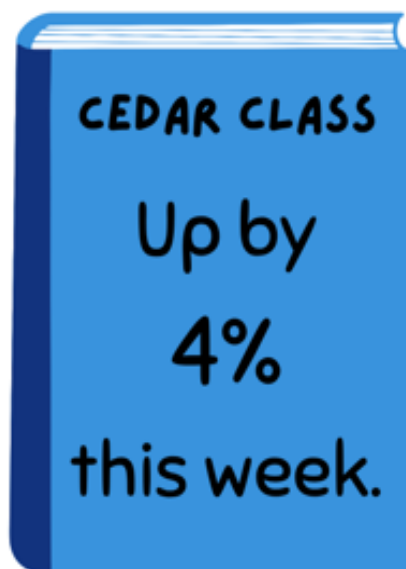
You must take a photo of your sunflower with you standing next to it and email it to the office by the 13<sup>th</sup> July, along with your sponsor money and sponsor forms.

This year, we have set our accelerated reader users a challenge – which class can improve their reading the most this year?

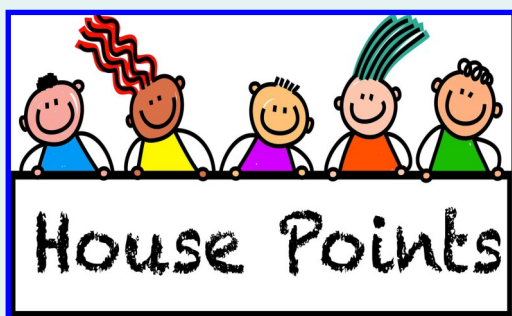
At the end of each half term, the class who has improved their word count by the highest percentage will win extra playtime!

Keane in Chestnut Class made a lovely Lego construction at home.


