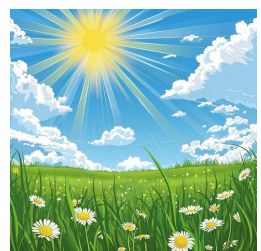

SUN SAFETY AT SCHOOL

With the hot weather we have been having recently we would like to remind all parents of the below sun safety recommendations.

5. Provide lightweight, loose-fitting layers.

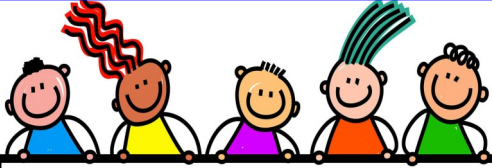
BEAUPRE'S SUNFLOWER COMPETITION

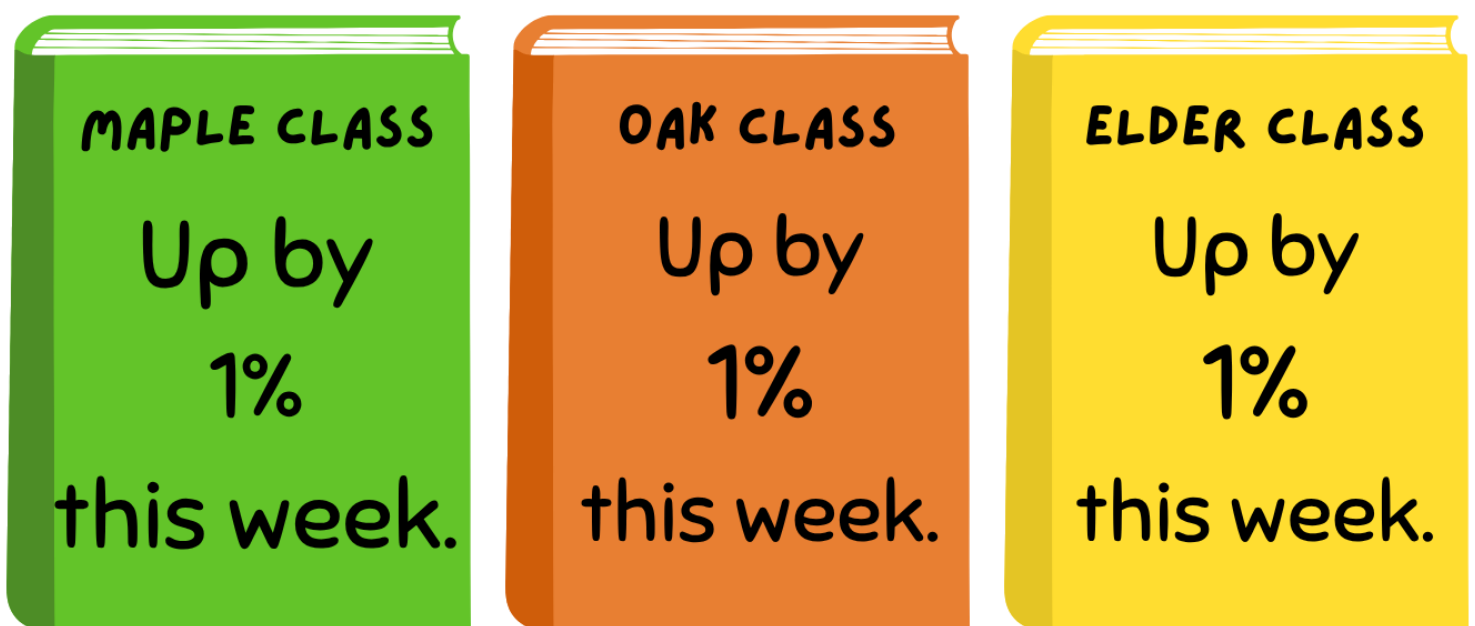
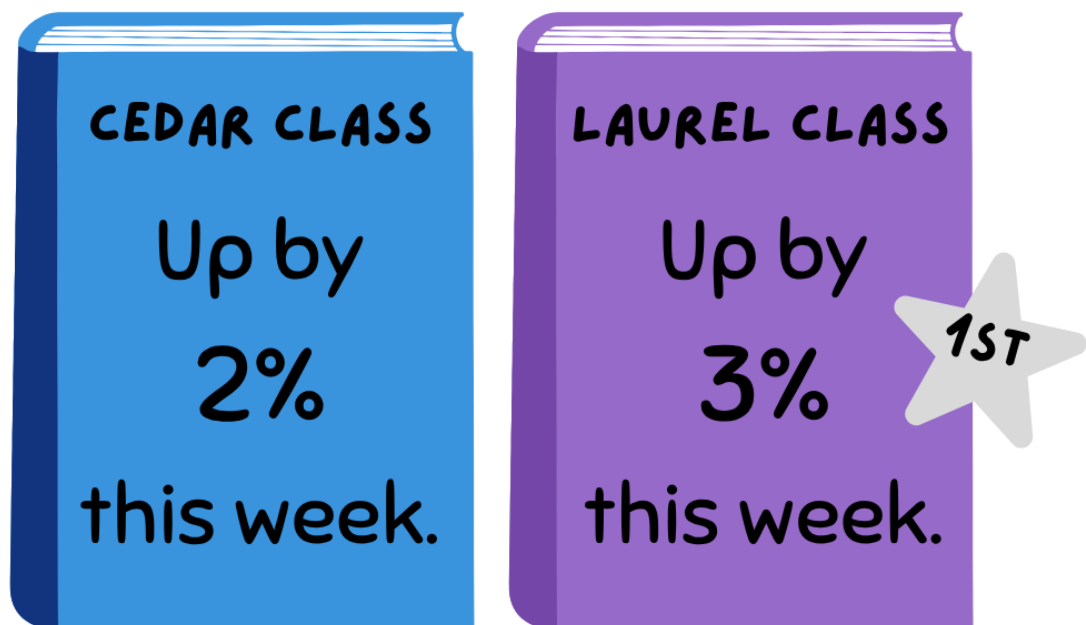
