Maple Class had a warm visit to the forest on Wednesday afternoon. The children really enjoyed sitting in the shade doing some creative activities.

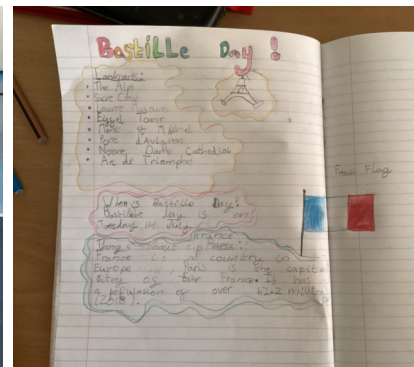
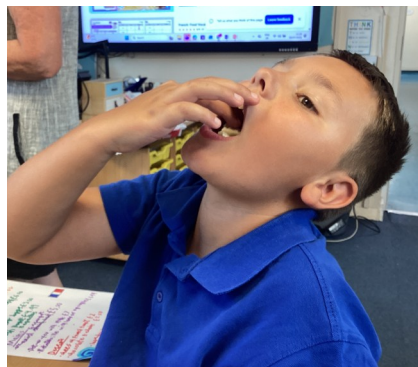
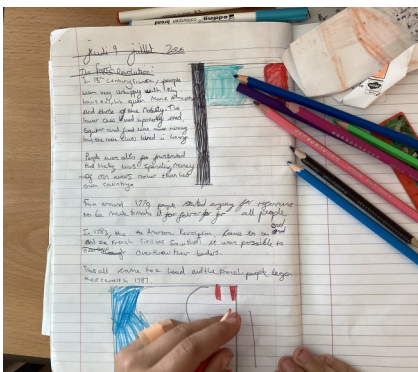

Throughout the day, the children enjoyed a whole range of French themed activities. Laurel Class Bikeability

As I am sure many of you know, we run an annual Level 2 Bikeability course for our Year 5 children. This prepares them for safe cycling on the road by improving their skills and confidence and educating them on road safety. This year, we have also provided a Level 1 session for our Year 3 pupils to prepare them for off-road cycling.

The session consisted of several hours in the school playground with a qualified instructor, who led the children through a series of games to teach them important cycling skills. The children learned how to use gears, avoid hazards, remain balanced without stabilisers, brake safely and even to cycle one handed so they could master signalling.



They all did a fantastic job, and received certificated for their hard work. Very well done to our Laurel Class cyclists!

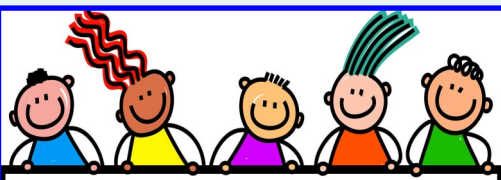

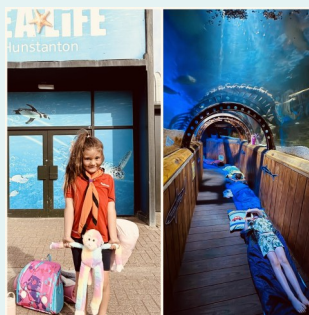
Outside Achievements
