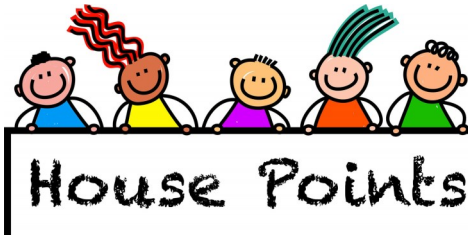


Attendance
