The choir and children sang carols, with pupils in Year 6 delivering readings to tell the Christmas story. It was a real delight to see so many families and residents joining together at this time of year.

Election Week

Beaupre has had a very exciting week and have caught 'election fever'! Years 5 and 6 have used the general election as a forum from which to collaboratively learn.

On Monday, the children had the opportunity to learn about the history of politics and thoroughly explore associated vocabulary. They even had the opportunity to impartially discover about the main political parties through guest speakers. The children were then able to use this information to produce non-chronological reports. Consequently, the children formed their own political parties and considered suitable names, emblems and mottos. They used their knowledge about what they had learnt about politics to produce their own manifestos which formed the basis of their party political broadcasts.



As well as writing persuasive letters to their 'electorate', they pitched their manifestos on Thursday afternoon and Friday morning to Years 2, 3 and 4 in a hope to acquire votes for their parties. These classes then had a chance, after considering what parties represented, to vote for their political party of choice. Those who were eligible to vote completed their ballot papers to find out which political party would gain power. The results of Beaupre's General Election will be announced to the children in Monday's assembly.




Attendance
