If your child was born between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016 you will need to apply for a primary school place in reception for September 2020.

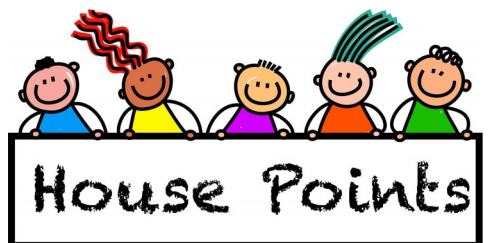
**You must submit your application online before the deadline of 15 January 2020 and you will receive your offer on 16 April 2020.**

Check you are applying to the [correct council](#). If you are a Cambridgeshire resident you will make your application through the Cambridgeshire Admissions Team, even if you want to apply for a school outside of Cambridgeshire. Likewise if you are a Norfolk resident you will make your application through the Norfolk Admissions Team even if you are applying for a Cambridgeshire school.

## Jewellery and PE

We would like to issue a polite reminder regarding jewellery in PE sessions.

Cambridshire County Council guidelines state that;

*All watches, jewellery and cultural or religious adornments must be removed. This includes earrings, studs and sleepers. If such items cannot be removed the individual is not prepared in an acceptably safe way and cannot continue as is, so must take part in modified activity.*

As a school we do not accept responsibility for removing studs or sleepers and recommend that these be removed at home on PE days. We will provide an envelope for those children who are able to remove their earrings themselves to store them.

In the case of recent piercing and their being unable to remove earrings, students will be required to make them safe by taping front and back, which may offer a measure of protection (e.g. from someone or from equipment such as a ball).

The taping may be done at home for younger children or prior to the lesson for older students with tape provided from home. Staff will not remove or tape earrings for students. Where staff consider the taping to be unsatisfactory to permit safe participation, they will consider alternative involvement in the PE lesson for that student.

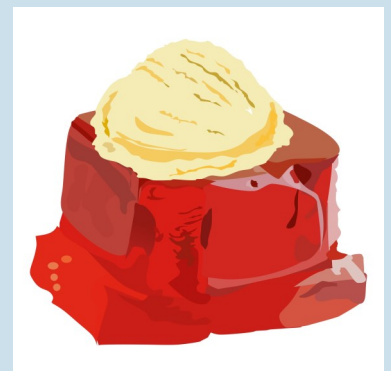
## Coming Up ...
